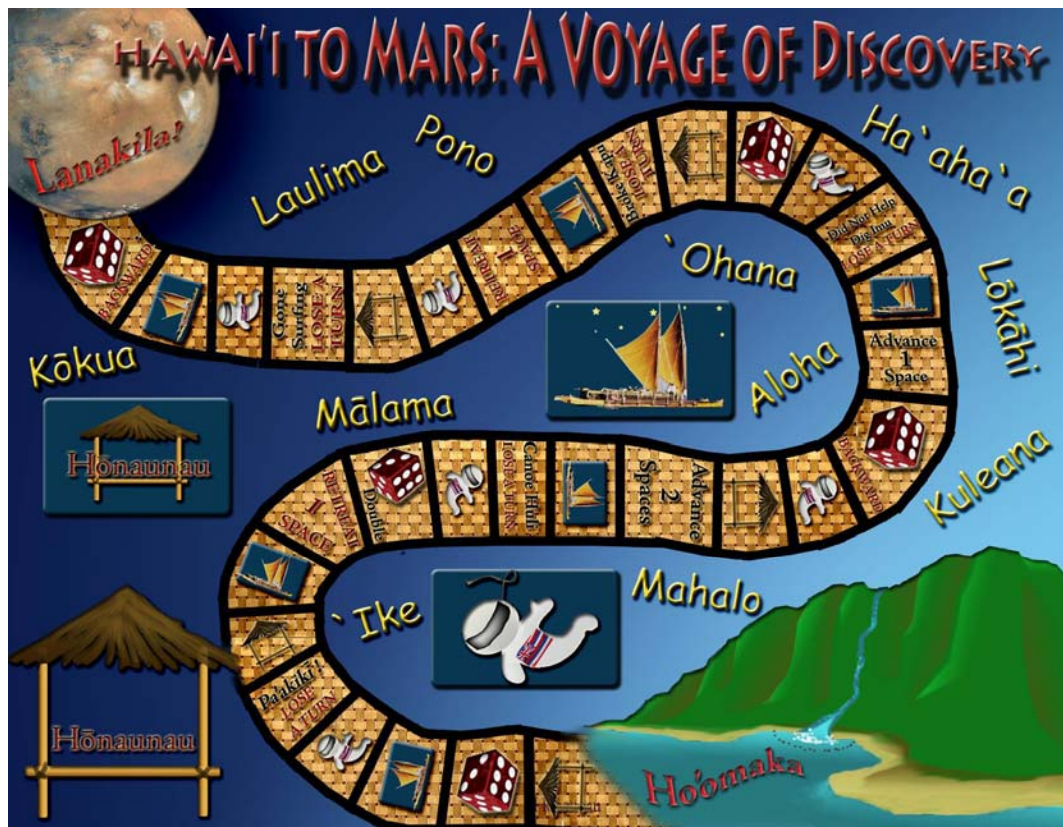


Teachers' Workshop: "Bringing Mars Science to Hawaii's Students"
